· A Message/opportunity to the company:

"My name is Jocelyn Moore- I'm a senior student at UD and I was a classmate of Janae Pringle. When asked her if she knew of any talented actors on campus, particularly actors of color, who might be interested in a social justice piece I'm working on, she pointed me toward HTAC! Below is more information about it all. Read it over and let me know what you think!

One of my passions is anti-human trafficking, and I've realized that one of the biggest issues in the fight against trafficking stateside is that the potential-victims are never properly educated about the problem. So I've created the Now You Know Project, which is a project to educate at-risk youth about the issue.

The project has two parts: (1) a theater piece and (2) a website designed to be a tool for further education as well as for follow up for teachers and educators. The theater piece is being written by my good friend Kirsten Sughrue, who is a Theater major at Montclair State University. It is less of a play and more of a series of monologues performed from the viewpoint of survivors. Though intended for a high school-aged audience, the content is going to be raw and real. In total, the performance will be around 30-45 minutes.

So, as you have probably guessed by now, I am looking for actors to perform in the theater piece. The first (and, as of now, only) performance is going to be sometime in early March, to an audience of teens from an after-school program in inner-city Wilmington. I need at least three actors, two of them actors of color, and one of them male. The performance is going to be sometime in early March, and rehearsals would be once a week leading up to the performance, and at a time that is best for the actors. I'm hoping to start rehearsals as soon as I receive the final copy of the script. Each actor will also be given a small stipend (I'm still figuring out the amount).

Does it sound like something you'd be interested in? Or at least would want to hear more information about? I look forward to hearing from you!"
